The lighting designs embrace organic structures with classical proportions, whimsically composed in brass, steel, and blown glass. Each design is available in the full range of latesta Studio finishes, alongside several new finishes developed in collaboration with Barry, including Garden Zinc and Washed Khaki. The artisan's touch is a constant presence in this collection, which continues to broaden and captivate with its innovation and allure.

At the heart of each piece is the finish with an aged yet refined appearance, a seal of performance. The finish goes beyond application and layers; it is part vaticination while controlling the material, medium, temperature, and ambient humidity. In essence, it is Art meets Alchemy.

POTTING CONSOLE

Many metalworking skills come together to execute this truly useful piece. The tray is formed by hand and clad in several layers of steel. The legs are forged into shape and joined with the perforated metal shelf, all atop durable casters. The finish has been clad for indoor and outdoor use, resisting rust and wear. Fill the tray with ice as a bar or dirt as a potting console.

"Generously scaled metal cart for use inside or out. Created for a client for watering her potted plants, we now employ this most often as a bar. Gurney wheels allow easy mobility as a bar cart or for potted plants seeking sun. Great in informal areas inside or for porches, verandas, or covered terraces."

SYNAPSE PENDANT - SIZE I

12" Dia. x 14.75"H

The name says it all, and you know exactly what it means when you see the intricate cluster of brass work representing the erratic synapses in one's brain. This element is the highlight of this design, suspended in mid-animation and captured in a blown glass orb. When clustered together with multiple orbs, the effect is quite special. Multiple sizes and configurations of globes available.

"Coils of multi-toned brass vines intertwine around a luminous Edison bulb encased in a hand-blown glass orb. A great catalyst for multiple metal finishes in a room is mixing the sinuous interior strands in multiple tones, such as bronze, brass, and pewter."

We show several standard configurations of multiple Synapse Pendants attached to a single ceiling plate; however, the possibilities are endless when mixing the two-size pendants at multiple heights and locations. They create a suspended sculpture while providing subtle illumination to great effect. We envision these centered in a grand three-story staircase or floating above a dining or center table.












NETTIE DARR TABLE

This table represents the distillation of Victorian and Empire styles to its core structure, making this a truly transitional design. Cast glass and claw feet are a reference to Victorian design, and they do so without weighing down the table with excessive ornament. The Empire pedestal and top are the skeletal structure of the traditional wood piece, all connected with woven mesh to unite the form. Every line in the pedestal is a compound curve fabricated by hand, truly a work of high craftsmanship.

MESH PEDESTAL CABINET - SIZE I - V.I

Though this cabinet references wood cabinetry techniques and elements, with inset panels and delicate trim moldings, it is rendered completely in steel. The woven mesh mimics woven cane panels, morphing the contents displayed on the shelves to nebulae of color.



"A translucent mesh pedestal with left- and right-facing doors is used to store books and collectibles. Solid top may hold vessels/statuaries. Designed to provide maximum storage while consuming minimum space... a "barely there" design." - Barry Dixon





MESH PEDESTAL CABINET - SIZE II - V.2

23.5"W x 23.5"D x 72"H

A second version of our Mesh Pedestal Cabinet with more traditional lion's paws referencing 18th-century design in a clearly contemporary fashion.

OEUF PENDANT - SIZE II

18.5"Dia. x 34"H Custom sizes and finishes available

This pendant balances the tension between its elements. The delicate, transparent globe is captured inside the open, minimal cage of rigid steel framing. The overall restraint of the design required very fine metal working skills, eliminating all visible welds between the puzzle pieces of the frame, resulting in a clean, contemporary light fixture.

"Inspired by our hens' eggs on our Virginia farm, an egg-shaped oval cage of six arched bars holds a luminous handblown glass orb with a filament bulb nucleus that works anywhere and everywhere." - Barry Dixon







VENTURA PEDESTAL

24"W x 24"D x 60"H
Custom sizes and finishes available

Woodworking techniques abound with inset woven panels surrounded by delicate moldings atop Lion's paw feet. Ideally suited for outdoor use with light and breeze passing through the woven stainless-steel mesh. The overall shape of the pedestal references Egyptian obelisks, seen worldwide in city centers; Place de la Concorde comes to mind.

"An elegant pedestal of translucent steel mesh with lion's paw feet. I designed this originally as an elegant garden piece but then found so many places for it in our interiors. Perfect for large pots and planters, garden urns, statuary or large vases and sculptures. Works in a hallway, garden room, foyer or living area. Safe inside or out!" - Barry Dixon
